PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING STATEMENTS BEFORE SIGNING YOUR APPLICATION:

1. NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY:

The Bolivar Energy Authority is the recipient of federal financial assistance from the Rural Electrification Administration, an agency of the U. S. Department of Agriculture, and is subject to the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended by the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, as amended, and the rules and regulations of the U. S.
